FSO FILM CONTEST “Adventure”

Attention film students! The FSO’s Student Film Contest opens Feb 1 with the winning film shown on the big screen as the symphony performs its March 15, 2025 concert “A Salute to Mother Earth.”

Who is eligible? The contest is open to any HS student from the region (Fredericksburg City, King George, Stafford, Spotsylvania, Orange).

Requirements for submission include:

- Film must be **entirely original**, with footage taken by the student.
- **Help?** Students may utilize **faculty** for advice and consultation only. Teachers must be credited in the final frame.
- **Footage:** must promote the Fredericksburg region’s ample environmental treasures, scenery and wildlife.
- **Sound:** There will be **no sound** to the film, but it should include captions for locations and credit rolls.
- The film should match the spirit of **Robert Bradshaw’s “Adventure”** which will be performed with the film at the concert (see fredericksburgsymphony.org for music).
- **Film length:** should match the music at 5:24 (see link above). This includes opening title and closing credits.
- **A title** be included in text for the opening of the film. The title must have the word “Adventure” in it to honor the music (e.g. “Rappahannock Adventure”. Your name and school must be included in the final frame, along with any faculty members who assisted you.
- **Tech Requirements:** Film must be in .mp4 or .mov format at a 1920X1080 format and video should be shot horizontally.
- **Deadline:** Submissions must be uploaded into our Dropbox no later than March 1, 2025. No late submissions will be considered.
